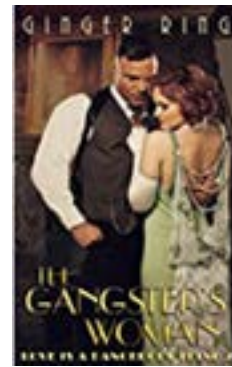
Randi Alexander

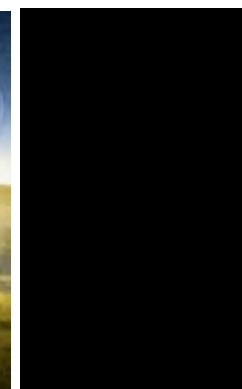
Sara Dahmen

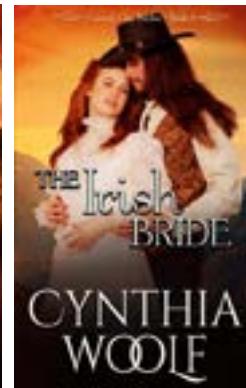


Cynthia Woolf

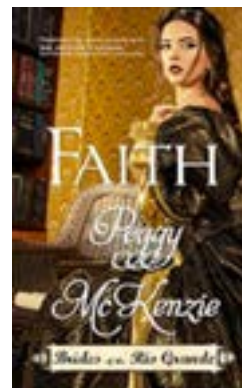
Melissa Keir
