














Linda Rae Sande

She holds a Masters in English literature and worked as a professional dancer, singer, journalist, and literature teacher. When not writing, she roams around to discover new places to










Randy Weir

LoRee Peery






















Iewelz Baxter

McKayla Jade








Brooke May




Jason Lee Willis




Michel Prince






Maggie Adams


Deanna Jewel











Amanda Sowers
